- f. Radio / TV Clubs

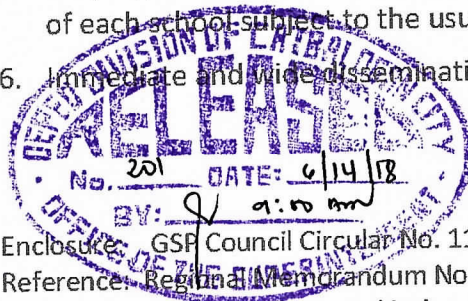
3. Participants of this conference are


