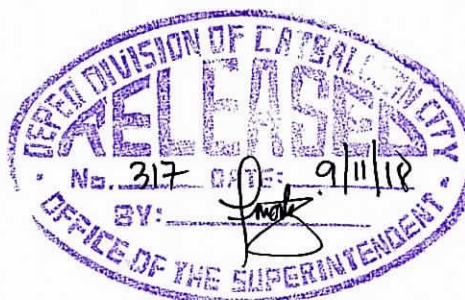



EDUCATOR'S LIFE CARE CONVERSATION, ARTSHOP AND PLAYSHOP CONFERENCE

INTRODUCTION

Educators' lives are replete with narratives of dedicated service to students and the academic world. Their stories talk of challenges they face, and inspiration, greatness, and triumphs they gained at work and in their personal lives. All through their teaching years, they serve without hesitation and with unwavering commitment to change the life of every child to become useful and successful citizen of the world. Their passion for teaching has led them to stay in this profession for years until they reach their age of retirement. Indeed, teaching is one of the noblest profession.
